Applications are now open for the 2021 Surf Life Saving Sunshine Coast 18+ Advanced Lifesaving Program, PULSE. The development program will be held **Friday 19th November – Sunday 21st November, 2021** at the Metropolitan Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club. Live-in and live-out accommodation options are available, and meals will be provided.

This program will extend the participant's lifesaving knowledge and skills in a hands-on, scenario-based learning environment. PULSE is open to **any** patrolling member over the age of 18! Ideally, we encourage all clubs to identify 1-2 participants to apply for the program, ideally you would send new or emerging PCs and other operational leaders.

Who: The program is open to all active Surf Life Saving Sunshine Coast members over the age of 18 (any patrolling member) who hold a proficient Bronze Medallion.

Registration: There are a very limited number of places available on this program so we strongly encourage applying early! Applications **must** be completed online at:

Applications will close **COB Thursday 28th of October 2021**

Cost: \$170 + GST per participant.

This registration fee includes all meals, program activities, program resources and PULSE memorabilia. The Sunshine Coast Branch will invoice Clubs for the total cost of all participants who are accepted to attend. Accommodation will be additional.

PLEASE NOTE: *Completing the application does not confirm acceptance to the development program. Members are encouraged to discuss attendance at the program with their club as all nominations will be sent to clubs for endorsement. In addition, payment for attendance will be the responsibility of the participant via the club unless other arrangements are in place within your club to fund member attendance. This program in its entirety is subject to change if required as a result of Queensland Health or Queensland Government COVID19 advice or restrictions.*

Any applicant that withdraws from the camp after being selected will not receive a refund; however the Club may be able to nominate an alternative participant.

Transport: All participants will be responsible for their own transport to and from the PULSE program.

Blue Card: All participants will require a current working/volunteering with children blue card.
