### Vaccination Status Form - Surf Clubs

**The below is an important message for ALL CLUB MEMBERS over 16 years of age with information extracted directly from an SLSQ Circular in regards to the submission of vaccination status by all members prior to 31 March 22.**

WE ASK THAT YOU PLEASE FOLLOW THE BELOW ACTION REQUEST PRIOR TO 31 MARCH 22**

#### HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR VACCINATION CERTIFICATE TO OUR CLUB

To administer the submission of vaccination certificates, SLSQ has implemented a process which we are asking for all of our members to please follow. This portal will allow members to self-administer the upload of their certificates. This can be accessed via <http://vacstatus.lifesaving.com.au>

- Members will be required to add in the following information:  
Vaccinations Status (please note the options are fully, partially or unvaccinated)
- Please note: that fully vaccinated is considered to be double vaccinated
- If up to date, they need to provide the Date of last vaccination and the Certificate
- If partially vaccinated they need to provide the date of booking for the vaccination
- If unvaccinated provide the date of booking for your 1<sup>st</sup> vaccination

Once members have submitted information you will be provided with a confirmation email.

#### Exemptions

Exemption requests will be handled by SLSQ centrally. **All requests are to be emailed to [slsq@lifesaving.com.au](mailto:slsq@lifesaving.com.au).**

They are to be titled: Covid Vaccination Exemption Request : John Citizen (ABC SLSC)

Information that is to be included is as follows Members Name, Members Club, Reason for Exemption and proof (please see the SLSQ FAQs as it relates to reasons)

Exemptions will be assessed by SLSQ Personnel and a determination will be made and conveyed to the member, members club and branch.

Please note: that any exemption request that includes derogatory or offensive language towards SLSQ or its staff/volunteers will be referred for disciplinary action. SLSQ understands and acknowledges that many people are against vaccination for a variety of reasons and have chosen not to have them. However, this does not allow nor give members the right to abuse the staff whether it be verbally or in writing.
