Step 1

Membership

Renew and pay your membership: SLS Members Area

Step 2

Blue Card

Ensure your blue card is current and linked with MSLSC. If you need to renew your blue card, please follow the step here: How to renew your Blue Card.

Step 3

Member Protection Courses complete

SLSQ Child Youth Risk Management Strategies (CYRMS) & Complete SLS Child Safe Awareness.

- Go to your SLS Members Area SLS Members Area
- eLearning > You will need to log in again to be directed to the SLSQ Hub
- On the dashboard of your SLSQ Hub you must have all 5 green ticks



If you have a red icon for CSA and CYRMS on your dashboard, this means these awards are not up to date. To update your CSA and/or CYRMS, complete the course online by clicking the tile with the red icon.

Step 4

Online Theory

- Login to SLS Members Area SLS Members Area
- eLearning > You will need to log in again to be directed to the SLSQ Hub
- Click on the 'Skills Maintenance' icon > You will need to log in again
- Go to 'Training Library'
- Click on the '2023 Skills Maintenance' view courses
- Enrol BM or SRC Theory (as applicable) *There is no theory required for Radio ART or First Aid
- Complete the course (there is no need to print the certificate)
 - *When completed, your records will show on the assessor app when you register for the Skills Maintenance Events.
 - *Once you have enrolled in the theory, it will sit under your 'My Training'



Step 5

Enrol

You must register for the event dates you would like to attend

- Go to SLS Members Area SLS Members Area
- eLearning > You will need to log in again to be directed to the SLSQ Hub
- Click on the 'Skills Maintenance' icon > You will need to log in again
- Go to 'Training Event'
- Find the event dates you wish to book > click enrol
- You will receive a confirmation email

FAQs

Tuesday Dry Skills Session Details

- Timed to start at 6.15pm. Please arrive and queue up by 6.00pm. Sign-on will cease at 7pm.
 - Everyone will be checked in, numbered, enrolment details checked and grouped into clusters.
 - All "locally based" members are asked to attend on Tuesday night to allow the weekend session to run more effectively. On the weekend, there with less assessors available to assist with the dry sessions.
- Location Mooloolaba SLSC
- Meeting Place:- Enter the surf club from the member's access stairs on the beachfront leading to the grassed area and flag poles. The session will be held upstairs in the club. This is part of the licensed area, so we are required to comply with the licensed club's dress standards for the session.

Weekend Wet and Dry Skills Sessions

- Timed to start at 7.45 am. Please arrive by 7.30am. Everyone will be checked in, numbered, enrolment details checked and grouped into clusters. Sign-on will cease at 9am.
- Meeting Place: Enter the surf club from the members access stairs on the beachfront leading to the grassed area and flag poles.
